Higashimiya Site Mansion No. 1 (Kawarahata Village)

Mansion No.1 is considered to be the residence of the person who was the village official of Kawarahata village. The main building of Mansion No.1 has a structure built on top of a platform made over the foundation stone. It was a large-scale building of about 21m in east-west direction and about 12m in north-south direction. The eastern half was laid with a wooden floor, with three guest rooms running in a row, along with a Tokonoma alcove. The western half had an earthen floor with entrances to the north and south, and a stable at the west end. The low-floor area called Agarihana was extended from the wooden floor section into the earthen floor section. In addition to the main building, there was a fertilizer hut, a barn, an attached hut, and a well in the mansion.
