## **Eating**

Various cooking utensils and tableware such as pots, kettles, kitchen knives, and grinding stones were found in the buried houses. In addition to the tray table set, porcelain and lacquer ware that are thought to have been used for daily meals, we also found formal tableware sets made of porcelain and lacquer, as well as tea ceremony sets from multiple houses. From this, we can imagine that in the Yamba area, occasions and events for gatherings with large numbers of people with guests were not uncommon.
