Sake Brewing

Since there was writing on a brush used for sake brewery exhibit Tenmei 2 (1782), it seems that sake was being brewed in Kawarahata village around that time. In the Edo period, sake brewing was not possible freely, but in Horeki 4 (1754), regulations were relaxed due to a good harvest of rice, and it became possible to start making sake (Horeki's self-brewing order). It is thought that sake brewing here also started from such a background.
